

CARE + CLEANING

— UPHOLSTERY VINYL —

Marine/RV grade vinyl, like all upholstery, requires a regularly scheduled cleaning program on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis, depending upon the exposure to dirt and/or other staining agents. It is important that efforts begin immediately after a spill to remove any potential staining agent.

Step 1:

Most common everyday light soiling can be easily removed using a solution of 10% liquid dish detergent and 90% warm water, applied with a clean cloth. Rinse with a clean cloth dampened with water and allow area to dry thoroughly. Moderate scrubbing with a soft bristle brush will help loosen dirt and grime embedded in the grain of the vinyl.

Step 2:

For more stubborn stains and heavy soiling, dampen a soft white cloth with Tilex® (or a similar product) or a mild detergent. Gently rub and then rinse with a clean cloth and water. Please note: do not use any "citrus formula" cleaners.

Step 3:

For the most difficult stains or surface mildew, dampen a clean white cloth with a solution of 10% household bleach and 90% water. Rub gently and rinse with water.
