

Infinity – MAT KIT TEMPLATE INSTRUCTIONS

Four Easy Steps

1 - Create Pattern

2 - Mark Template*

3 - Cut & Check Template

4 - Mail Template

*Teak patterns will take an extra step

Check List

Durable, heavy plastic (min 6mil)

It should not stretch when pulled tight or hold a crease.

Marking pen

Straight edge

Scissors

Packing, Masking or Painters tape

Ruler (*especially for Teak patterns)

1 - Create Pattern *(For best results, we encourage making the template from scratch and not using existing mats.)*

- Lay template material on the floor of boat, arranging material to lie flat
- Leave a 1/2" gap around the edges for drainage, draw or cut around edges of desired mat pieces. Be careful to avoid any slipping or movement of material.
- Make sure all corners are rounded on your template.
- Draw or cut around pedestal seats, table holes and any other areas that you want. Use dash lines to indicate slits, such as access slits for table holes and hatch lid flaps.

2 - Mark Template

For each piece being sent, ensure to:

- Draw an arrow showing direction of bow (†)
 - Write TOP on the side that will face up when complete
 - Write your Complete Name and Phone Number (ex: Yanni Yachter 555-555-5555)
 - Notate total number of pieces (mark as 1 of 3, 2 of 3, etc)
 - Write Infinity collection, color and backing (ex: Seagrass color 7 CC)
- *For Teak collections, line up template sections as they will appear on the boat and draw at least three teak lines on each template piece. The lines should be 3" apart as they should appear on the final flooring.

3 - Cut & Check Template

- Cut template along lines that you have drawn including seats, table holes & bolsters (do not cut access slits as it could distort the template pieces)
- We charge a \$25 administrative fee for any mat kits not cut out completely.
- MUST NOT MISS THIS STEP: Reinstall the template and check the final fit. Make sure the template lies flat, with no bubbles or wrinkles. Your new mat kit will be an exact representation of your template. All corners, inside and out, will need rounded corners. Make any adjustments necessary before shipping!
